RECEPTION HOURS

Reception is open Mon-Friday, 7.30 am – 7.30 pm, Saturday, 8 am - 6 pm, Sunday, 9 am - 5 pm. Public holiday hours may vary. If you need to contact us from your room, please dial 9 to reach us at reception.

CHECK-IN

Check-in is from 2.00 pm. If you require an earlier check-in, please call our friendly team to organise. Early check-in is subject to availability.

CHECK OUT

Check-out is by 10.00 am. If you require a late check-out, please request with our friendly team upon check-in, subject to availability. An additional charge may be incurred. Luggage storage is available. Please contact reception.

PARKING

Parking is within the courtyard. There is no designated parking, and it operates on a first in first served basis. Provision has been made for one car park per accommodation unit. Additional parking is available at the back of the Restaurant area.

SWIMMING POOL

Pool hours are 7.30 am – 8 pm. Pool towels can be found in the vanity cupboard in the bathroom. No lifeguard is on duty. Parents and guardians are responsible for the safety of any children and themselves. We ask that you observe the following rules for the safety of yourself and others:

- The pool is for the use of house guests only.
- An adult MUST accompany any children under the age of 15.
- No running, jumping, diving, bombing, no eating or drinking is permitted in the pool area.
- Strictly NO glass or bottles allowed in the pool area. Strictly NO alcohol or food is to be in the pool area.
- No throwing of objects or objectionable behaviour is permitted
- Small children and babies must wear swimwear nappies.

BBQ

The BBQ located in the pergola is free for guests to use. Contact reception for additional tools and/or if you require assistance in lighting the BBQ. We ask that you keep the area tidy and switch off the BBQ and lights. Please also ensure that the BBQ plate is clean after use.

GUEST LAUNDRY

Located next to Room 5 and is open from 7.30 am to 8 pm. The laundry contains a washing machine and a dryer. Each machine makes 2×1 coins per load. Washing powder is available to purchase at reception for 2 per sachet. Each guest room contains an ironing board and iron.

MINI-BAR

For your convenience, all rooms have a minibar that is refreshed daily. We hold an on-premise Liquor Licence and can provide you with alcoholic beverages in your room.

COMPLIMENTARY COFFEE AND TEA

Complimentary tea, coffee, hot chocolate and plunger coffee have been provided in your room. Milk is available at reception.

TOILETRIES

Complimentary sustainable toiletries are located in the vanity area of your bathroom.

HOUSEKEEPING

Your room will be serviced daily. If you do not want your room serviced, please display the 'Do not disturb' sign on the front door.

EXTRA BEDDING

Extra pillows and blankets are located in the wardrobe or cupboard of each guest room.

IN-ROOM APPLIANCES

For your convenience, an electric kettle, hairdryer, iron, microwaves, and mini fridge are provided in your room. Select rooms only offer stoves, cooktops and ovens. TVs offer digital free-to-air channels.

Toasters are provided in your room. Keep the control set at a low temperature; burning the toast will automatically activate your room's fire/smoke alarm detector. A cost is incurred to the guest account if the Fire Brigade is called to the property.

IN-ROOM COOKING

In accordance with Government Health and Safety Regulations, cooking is not permitted in Motel units that do not have full kitchen facilities other than beverage, toast and warming of foods, where, for those purposes, facilities are provided, including a microwave. Limited cutlery and crockery are supplied to each room.

AIR CONDITIONING/HEATING

Each unit features its own individually controlled Split System Reverse Cycle Air Conditioner. The air conditioner remote control is located on the wall near the unit. These air conditioners are extremely effective and would be very appreciated if you could turn off the unit when you leave the room. Keep doors and windows closed for optimal efficiency. Please contact reception if you require further assistance or if the unit is not working.

Operating procedure: Check that the 'mode' is in the correct setting for either heating or cooling. i.e. the icicle symbol is for cooling, and the sun is for heating.

BATHROOM HEATING – Rooms 1 -10

Rooms with Fan Heaters – ON button is located near the bathroom door. Press the button once to operate. The heater will stop automatically after 10 minutes. Rooms with Ceiling Heating Lamps – The switch is located near the Bathroom door.

BATHROOM EXHAUST FANS

The exhaust fans are automatic and operate between the hours of 7:00 AM – 10:00 AM and 6:00 pm – 10:00 PM. Keep bathroom doors closed to minimise noise.

SPA BATHS

Warnings: Under no circumstances turn the spa bath on without water covering the main jets. Children must not be left unsupervised in or around the spa bath. Do not sit against the spa inlet valve or allow hair to become entangled near the inlet, which could result in serious injury.

Operating procedure: Fill the bath to cover the jets. To turn the spa on, simply press the ON/OFF button. Continually pressing the ON/OFF button may cause an airlock, in which case contact reception.

MAINTENANCE

We always strive to ensure the highest standards for our property. Should you require any assistance with the maintenance of your room or wish to report any faults, please contact Reception by dialling 9.

DAMAGES

Damages will be assessed and charged to the credit card we have on file. All guests are liable for any damage caused during their stay.

SECURITY

Please ensure that all doors to your room are secured at all times. Deadlocks are provided on guest room doors for extra privacy. Please do not leave valuables in your car.

LOST PROPERTY

We do not accept responsibility for lost items. Any lost property items are retained for a period of 2 weeks, after which any uncollected items will be disposed of or given to a local charity.

SMOKING/VAPING

Smoking and vaping are <u>NOT PERMITTED</u> in public areas and guest rooms. A \$150 fee will be charged on evidence of smoking or vaping in the rooms. Please consider other guests and smoke or vape well away from guest rooms.

NOISE REGULATIONS

Please respects other guests by limiting the noise between 9 pm and before 8 am. If you have any guests visiting, we ask that they leave by 9 pm. Please note that Management reserves the right to terminate, without refund, the booking of any guest who makes excessive noise at any time.

PET POLICY

NO pets are permitted on the property or in motel rooms per Government Health Regulations, with the exception of Certified Service Animals.

FIRST AID

A first aid kit is located at reception. Please let us know if we can be of assistance.
